



## HIGHLIGHTS

- Long lived, durable perennial
- Low growing, spreading
- High density
- Very fine texture
- Highly attractive
- Amazing root strength

### CHARACTERISTICS:

Spreading by pseudo-stolons (after vernalization) to form a very dense, highly attractive, durable turf with tightly intertwined horizontal tillers.

### TURF QUALITY:

Highly attractive, with a very fine texture and much greater density (10,000+ live shoots/ft<sup>2</sup>) than most regular turf type perennial ryegrasses with a very soft feel.

### MOWING AND MOWING HEIGHT:

Low mowing ( $\frac{3}{4}$ " or less) in the spring encourages spreading, density, and increases appearance. After May, normal mowing (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " or so) may resume.

### FERTILIZATION:

About 4 - 5 Lb. soluble N as complete fertilizer in a 3:1:2 NPK ratio. Emphasis on fall and late fall applications is beneficial.

### DISEASE ASPECT:

Spreading perennial ryegrasses have improved summer stress, considerable crown and strip rust, and leaf spot tolerance.



**COLOUR:** Medium to medium dark

**GERMINATION:** Within 6 - 7 Days

**DROUGHT AND SHADE TOLERANCE:** Same as other perennial ryegrasses

**THATCH PRODUCTION:** None
