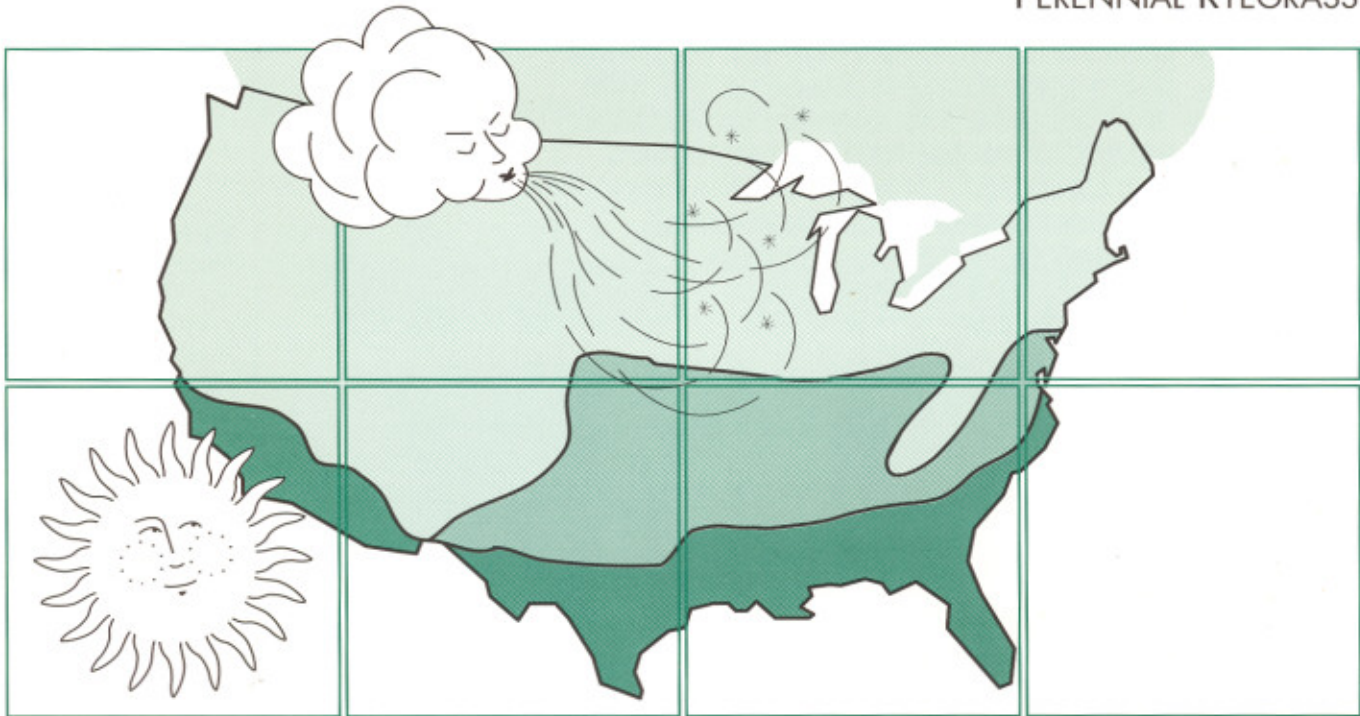

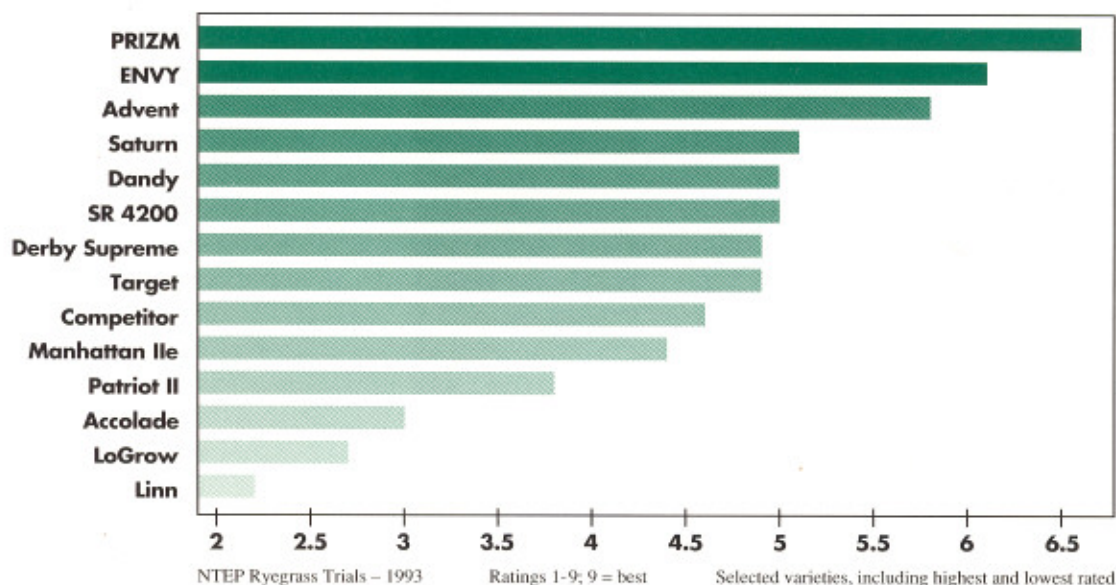

## ENVY—RESISTANCE TO BROWN PATCH



ENVY exhibits excellent overall resistance to disease, including common diseases such as red thread and brown patch. Brown patch is a particularly devastating disease during the hotter, high humidity seasons, and wherever air circulation is poor or maintenance levels of nitrogen high.

Ratings: Color and Red Thread Resistance are rated on a scale of 1 to 9; Spring Cover is based on percent. In all instances, higher scores denote better performance.

## SEEDING AND OVERSEEDING

ENVY establishes readily on bare soil or after verticutting existing turf for renovation and overseeding.

It should be applied at a rate of 5-7 lbs per 1000 sq. ft. for most new seeding applications. Periodic reseeding at 3-5 lbs per 1000 sq. ft. maintains density for superior durability and appearance.

For overseeding dormant bermudagrass, a rate of 30-40 lbs per 1000 sq. ft. is recommended for golf course greens, and 7-10 lbs per 1000 sq. ft. (300-400 lbs per acre) for tees, fairways and roughs.

## MAINTENANCE

ENVY grows well in areas of full sun to light shade. It mows cleanly at heights of 1/2". Because of its density and tillering ability, ENVY can be cut at greens heights when appropriate management practices are observed.
